

Installation

- A) Bevor you begin, rename your existing "WTF" and "Interface" folders (your Backup)
- B) Put downloaded folder "Interface" into your WoW folder
- C) Optional: Copy content from "Quarth_Additionals" into your WoW folder
- D) Take one "WTF" from 1920x1080/1680x1050/1600x1024/1600x900. Put it in you WoW folder (incl. config.wtf)
- E) Rename -AccountName -RealmName- -Charname- into your real names.

Ingame

- 1) Start WoW, check your language and realm and resolution! Activate all addons and login
- 2) Important! Type in Chat--> **/nefport 0 0 0 105**
- 3) Maybe Chatframe is misaligned (is stored Serverside), rightclick on chatregister to unlock and move it if your fontsize is to small or big go into interface and open BasicChats mods, fontsize should be "15" this gives a 9 line high chatframe.
- 4) If Minimap is misaligned (should not be). press hold down Shift and move it.
- 5) *Open Interface->addons and verify all addons are set to the Profile "Qarth" Often Dominos is not set to Quarth, type **/dom** and activate Dominos-Profile "Qarth" or Copy Qarth to your own Profile.
- 6) Type **/dom** in Chat and click "Configure Bars" in the Dominos Menu.
If you have a Petclass, middle click on bar10 to deactivate, move bar10 away and move petbar at the postion where bar10 was.
- 7) Drag you Spells into the Bars...after that lock it.
- 8) Click "Bind Keys" Button, hoover over Buttons and asign key's.
- 9) If you wish, disable "show emtpy buttons" in the Dominos menu.

*two addons are not visible in the Blizzard Addon menu, until you load GUI by chat command. Type in chat
/ouf
/kgpanels

Dominos (ActionBar)

/dom

ouF Nivaya (Unitframe)

/ouf

the only ouF who has an ingame config menu, you must open it by chat-command.

KuiNameplates

/knp

Auras/Castbar/Combopoints are disabled, activate it in the Kui menu, if you need it.

Skada (Dmg Meter)

/skada config

Handling is very easy. Rightclick on Skada brings you back

leftclick forward. Use your Mousewheel to scroll up and down. Skada can store max 50 segments. Deleting all Data by clicking on the second Icon from the right in the Skada menubar.

TipTac (Tooltip)

/tiptac

I is not listet in the addon menu and it has his own config menu.

Ryv's Minimap

no GUI

to move; hold down Shift and drag Minimap.

wAlign (UI-Align Tool)

/wal 20

Puts a grid (of your size choice!) on top of your UI for easy UI component alignment.
'/wal' deactivates the grid.

pError (UI Text Filter)

/perror spell is not ready yet

/perror listen

/perror list

/perror reset

Simple addon to filter out any spam text in the UIErrorsFrame. Its designed to be robust and easy to use.

removes any text, in this case 'spell is not ready yet' from the UI

filters all errors

prints out your current filter list

to reset the filter list

Health Warning

/hw <treshold>

/hw 25

/hw text

/hw sound

Starts flashing the screen edges when you get low on health.

Sets the warning treshold

will set the treshold to 25% health

Toggles text warning on/off

Toggles sound warning on/off

opens a simple calculator.
